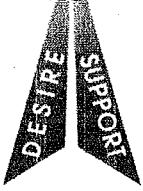

Johnson Mechanical Company just completed a major electrical (quarter of a million dollar) job at A. Warren McClaskey Adult Center. It involved bringing in a new transformer from the Sacramento Municipal Utilities District (SMUD), disconnecting the old, and installing multiple panels throughout the school so that the power can be distributed.

As I indicated above, it was a major project and could have interrupted things at school. However, because of the willingness of the staff at Johnson Mechanical to work around our schedule, we never had to close the school and no class had to be temporarily moved. The entire crew was very hard working and willing to work long hours so that we didn't have to disrupt our services. Not only did they work on weekends, but also on holidays (including New Year's Eve and New Year's Day) over winter break to assure that all would be up and running when staff returned from winter break.
